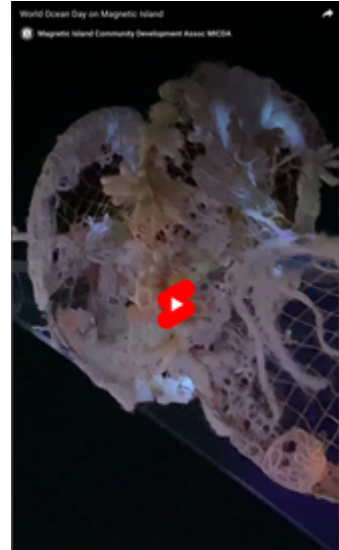
A CUBAN TASTE FOR ZERO WASTE
